



*The Ile Verte will charm you with its tranquillity and authenticity. Its rural character will even give you the impression of having stepped back in time. The latter includes a kitchenette where you can prepare your own meals; breakfast is served in the other house.*



## 16 CAP-DE-RABAST LIGHTHOUSE

For a summer vacation that's a little out of the ordinary, rent the lightkeeper's house and explore the fascinating world of the Île d'Anticosti by car or bike. With a European package plan, the Pourvoirie du Lac Genèviève (an outfitting operation) offers you a resort holiday at Pointe-Nord of the island, also called Cap-de-Rabast. Rabast refers to an area where boats take shelter to wait out bad weather.

5 CAP-CHAT LIGHTHOUSE

There is no better way to discover the Ile d'Anticosti and the Cap-de-la-Table lighthouse than to offer yourself a package tour with Safari Anticosti. In addition to eating and sleeping in the buildings next to the lighthouse, you will also have the opportunity to visit the lighthouse and many other of the island's natural and tourist attractions, accompanied by an experienced guide.

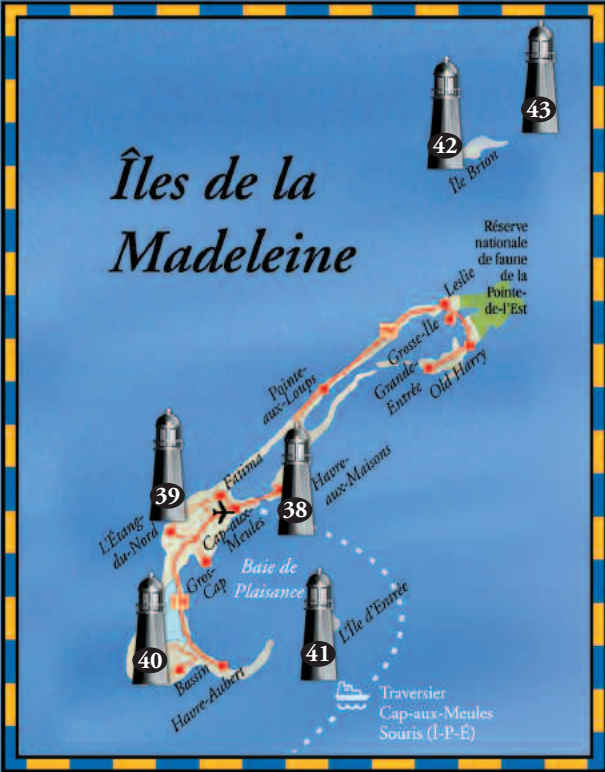
